The Stephenson Locomotive Society has been incorporated as a private company limited by guarantee, registered in England and Wales. The transfer of assets from the existing Society will take place on 1st January 2017. In tandem Chris Jenkins BSc., MCTSI of Maidstone replaces Martin Green as both the Company Secretary and the Society's General Secretary.
